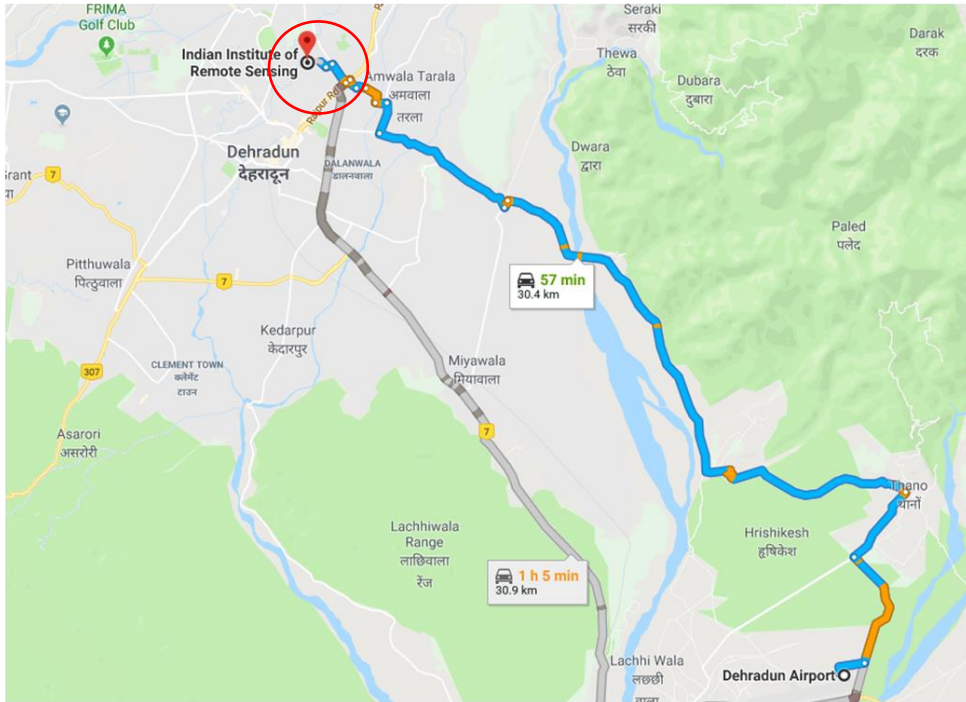
General Guidelines for the Participants

1. Participants are required to carry any valid government Identity card such as Departmental ID card, Aadhar card, voter card, passport, etc.
2. Original copy of the nomination letter from Principal or Head of the Institute is required. In case of self-nominating authorities such as Principal of the School or Director of the Institute the self-attested nomination letter with seal will be required.
3. The electronic gadgets such as Mobile phones, laptops, tablets, etc. will not be allowed inside the IIRS-ISRO campus. However all these items can be kept safely in the hostel where the accommodations are arranged. For local participants, all the electronics items have to be deposited at IIRS security gate.
4. The local transport and accommodation for all the outstation participants is arranged by IIRS-ISRO.
5. Participants are advised to look for the taxi driver holding IIRS-ISRO board outside the Airport or Railway station.
6. The mobile numbers of the participants are shared with the drivers. In case of any communication gap, the participants are advised to contact **Shri Krishna Gopal, Administrative Officer at 09760927395**.
7. The locations of IIRS-ISRO campus at Dehradun is as below:
 - Indian Institute of Remote Sensing, 4-Kalidas Road Dehradun, India
 - It's about 30 Km from Jolygrant Airport Dehradun, 5 Km from Dehradun Railway Station and 11 Km from Dehradun ISBT.
 - The Nearest landmark/location is DILARAM CHOWK located at Dehradun Mussoorie Road from where by taking left turn toward New Cant Road, the Kalidas Road can be approached by left after 500 meter near Post office at the place known as Hathibadkala. The location map is enclosed with this guidelines document as Annexure.
8. The accommodation for all the outstation participants is arranged at Golden Jubilee hostel in IIRS-ISRO Campus at Dehradun. The phone number of the Golden Jubilee Hostel Reception is **0135-2524333**

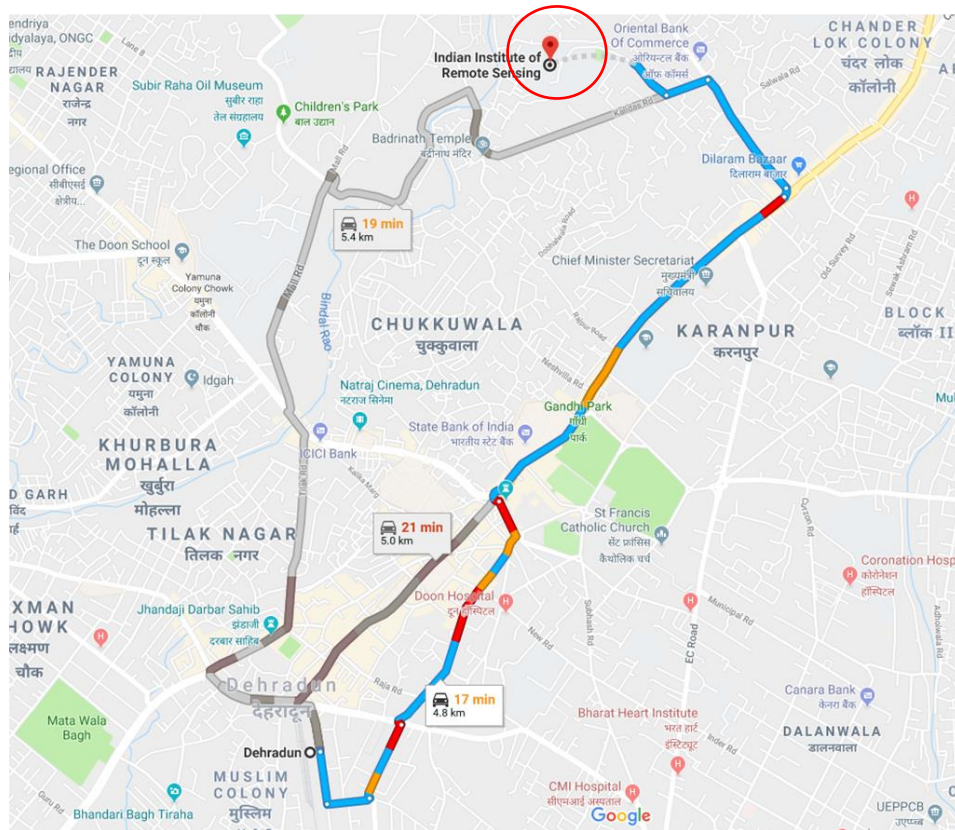
9. For any accommodation issues the warden Shri Kamal Pandey may be approached at **09634629886** (Please call in case of any difficulty only).
